Transportation System

The school has fleet of Buses to provide to & fro transportation facility to the students of the school.

The school transport will operate as per the rules prescribed:

- Details of school transport can be had from the school office.
- For any change in the bus arrangement, written requests stating adequate reasons should be made.
- No student shall be allowed to use the bus one way. The bus fee will be charged both ways.
- The transport fee is liable to change from time to time and may be revised at any time during the session.

Parents will avail the transport facility for their wards at their own risk. The school shall hold no responsibility in case of accident resulting in injury or otherwise to the students.

Rules & Regulations -

- 1. Every student should carry the school diary daily.
- 2. Students who come to school on their own should arrive at the school 5 minutes before the bell rings.
- 3. Students should attend the school in uniform prescribed for the season & should be habitually neat and clean.
- 4. Students coming late or absenting from the school without permission should bring proper application for leave from their parents/guardians.
- 5. Non-Sikh boys should get their hair-trimmed at regular intervals.
- 6. Shouting or whistling is not allowed in the school.
- 7. During the absence of the teacher from the class, students shall be under the discipline of the monitor.
- 8. Students should take utmost care of the school property and premises. Any kind of damage done even by accident should be reported at once to the Class Teacher or to the Principal. Students would be held responsible for any damage caused by him / her and shall be liable to compensate for the loss.
- 9. The school is not responsible for any goods lost. It is not advisable to bring valuable articles to the school.
- 10. The school reserves the right to suspend/expel students whose conduct is harmful to other students.
- 11. A student who fails twice in three years will not be permitted to continue his / her studies in the school.
- 12. The name, class and section of the pupils should be clearly marked on all woolen belongings of the students.
- 13. Students should bring the necessary text books, exercise books and any other requisite material.
- 14. Students are warned not to buy eatables from vendors outside the school.
- 15. Girls should not apply Nail Polish or Mehandi during term time.
- 16. Students should get their report cards signed by their parents/guardians within two days of its receipt.
- 17. Students should always remember that the school is judged by their conduct. They should greet their teachers when they meet them.
- 18. Results declared at the end of the year are final.
- 19. Should there be any infectious disease at home the students are not to be sent to school till the danger of infection has passed.

SCHOOL CURRICULUM -

The school curriculum is based on the educational needs of the students within the requirements of the C.B.S.E board examinations. The curriculum aims to promote a comprehensive educational programme, which shall equip the students with thorough knowledge and strong values. It also aims at instilling confidence in the students to face their Board examination effectively. The syllabus for each class is carefully planned to ensure that the student acquires a sound knowledge of basic concepts in all the subjects.

The learning process is further enriched by the teacher-designed worksheets, which are regularly provided to the students. Besides, the visual medium also forms an integral part of the curriculum to enhance student learning.

The school curriculum includes subjects ranging from English, Hindi and Computer to Physical Education, Music and Art. Besides, the curriculum for classes includes General Knowledge and Moral Science too.

House System -

DISCIPLINE

- English being the medium of instruction, all the teachers and students are required to use English language for academic work and general conversation in the school premises.
- Behaviour of the children at the campus and outside is our concern. All the movements of the students on the school campus must be orderly, quiet and purposeful. A student should stand upright and alert while wishing or conversing with the principal, a teacher or a visitor. All the students must be smartly dressed during school hours and must develop a habit of caring for personal cleanliness.
- During change of periods, the class monitor shall be authorized to mind the class.
- Pupils shall keep their class room in particular and school premises in general neat and clean and shall not disfigure the walls, scatter bits of paper on the floor or commit any other unhygienic act.
- No books (other than text or Library books), magazine should be brought to the school without the Principal's permission.
- Money should neither be lent nor borrowed nor the articles be exchanged by students.
- All letters and correspondence addressed to pupils are subject to scrutiny of the Principal.
- Running, playing, shouting and whistling inside the school building is never allowed.
- Parents and guardians are not permitted to walk into class- rooms or interview teachers during class hours.
- The name, standard and section of the pupil should be clearly marked on all his/ her belongings.
- No pupil may leave the school premises during the school hours and recess without the prior permission of the Principal.
- The students are not allowed to receive visitors or make phone calls during class hours unless the matter is very urgent and that too with the permission of the principal only.
- Any pupil to be exempted from P.T. or games must produce a medical certificate from a doctor to this effect that he/she is physically unfit to take part their in.

CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

In vocal music, there is option of both Western and Hindustani- classical and light fusion.

This also helps them bond with each other's culture through the universal language called music.
